We object on the grounds that			
1) There has been no ecological survey			
2) The soil stability survey shows grave concerns about the future stability of the site			
3) There is no water drainage plan			

4) No highways solution has been reached that is acceptable to Kent Highways
5) It contravenes the Sandgate Design Statement 9 – which states the necessity to protect the positive and distinctive contribution that the wooded skyline (escarpments) makes to the environmental character and appearance of Sandgate.'
6) The development would be out of balance with the other houses in the area
